Entitled “Pieces of the Mind” the exhibition focused on works of emerging artist Ryan Monteath, and seasoned artist Anna Silgado. “The most impressive thing is that, she is living the American dream” said honourable Navdeep Bains, MP who inaugurated the event which was emceed by Dr. Colin Saldanha.

“Pieces of the Mind” was an exhibition that acted as an extension to the murals Anna Silgado donated to the Central and Frank McKechnie Libraries in Mississauga. The creation of the murals at the Central Library prompted her to showcase the work of emerging talent Ryan Monteath. Ryan’s talent was clearly evident in the beautifully whimsical clouds he had airbrushed as murals in the childrens’ section of the Library.

The exhibition was also a platform for Anna to give back to the community by donating a piece of art to the Peel Children’s Centre to be auctioned.
